Call for papers

Plant breeding innovations contributed significantly to yield growth and arable production in the EU in the past two decades. Thereby, markets were stabilized, price volatility reduced and the EU agricultural net trade balance improved. Besides positive economic and social effects, plant breeding has also substantial environmental impacts. In view of the EU's "Farm to fork" and "Biodiversity" strategies within the European Green Deal, plant breeding is in particular challenged to compensate effects of an expected production decline due to significant reductions in the use of pesticides and fertilizers.

<u>The official conference language is English</u>. Usually oral presentations are limited to 15 – 25 minutes. Keynote lectures can be longer.

You will be informed by the organizers immediately after the deadline for submission of contributions, whether your contribution is accepted as oral presentation or as poster. We kindly request your understanding if your presentation will be accepted as poster because of time constraints.

For posters we recommend the size DIN-A0.

The conference fee is € 110.- for participants; € 90.- for members of Saatgut-Austria; and € 70.- for students (with a valid certificate only). The fee covers participation in the conference, coffee breaks, all documents (including proceedings) and the buffet at the conference dinner (drinks are at your own expense). For speakers we waive the conference fee.

We pay attention to your health and implement Austrian laws on COVID-19. Only people who have either been vaccinated, recovered or currently tested are allowed to participate in the conference. If the rules will change, we will inform all registered participants.

For participants travelling by train, a shuttle service from the station to the accommodation will be provided at your own cost.
