

Guidelines for manuscripts

60th Plant Breeders Conference in Gumpenstein, Austria. November 24-26, 2009

*Please hand in your manuscript **at the latest during** the meeting Nov. 24-26, 2009.*

Manuscript submission is possible:

- **Before and after the meeting**

- **During the meeting:**
hand in files on diskette, CD or USB-memory stick to Mrs. Manuela Geppner

!! No manuscripts will be accepted after December 15, 2009 !!

Manuscripts must not exceed

- for oral contributions: 36.000 characters (reduced by the space for figures and tables)
- for poster contributions: 12.000 characters (reduced by the space for figures and tables)

Please submit your manuscript as follows:

1. pdf-file or printout

including all tables and figures at the appropriate position and including any formatting. This print will be used by the editor as control to properly layout your manuscript for printing.

2. text document

Save your file in 'doc' format. Do not submit 'docx' files. If you are using another word processor, please save the file as 'plain text' or as 'rtf'

- Use Times New Roman; 11 pt; single spaced
- Use italics for genus and species names
- Do not use hyphenation, field functions or the space bar for indent
- Use no more than three levels of displayed headings
- Abbreviations should be defined at first mention and used consistently thereafter

The **title page** should include:

- Title
- Name of authors, their affiliations and addresses
- E-mail, telephone and fax numbers of corresponding author
- Abstract (150-250 words; no abbreviations and references)
- 4-6 Keywords for indexing purposes

Tables: Tables created by the table function are preferred. Tables made by spreadsheets (Excel) must be submitted as separate file (xls format). Please do not use frames, shading, etc.

3. Graphs, figures, pictures:

Figures must be submitted as separate files (jpg or tif format) with a minimum resolution of **300 dpi**.

!!! The proceedings will be printed in black and white. Make sure your **!!!**
graphs are clearly readable.

4. Citation:

In the text use “et al.” for more than two authors. Arrange references chronological when more than one work is cited. The list of references should only include works that have been published or accepted for publication. Personal communications and unpublished works should only be mentioned in the text. Reference list entries should be alphabetized by the last names of the first author of each work.
